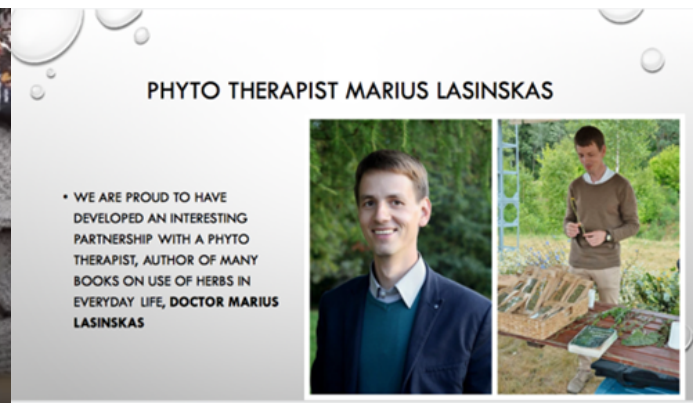
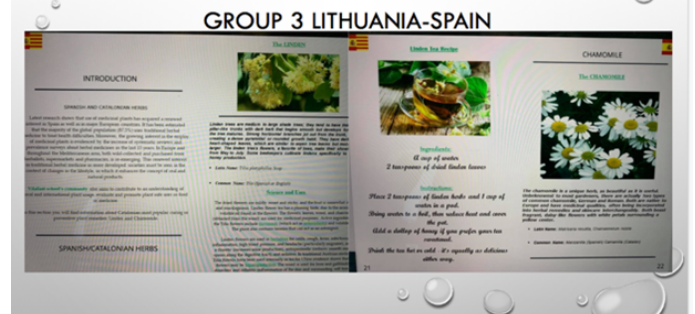
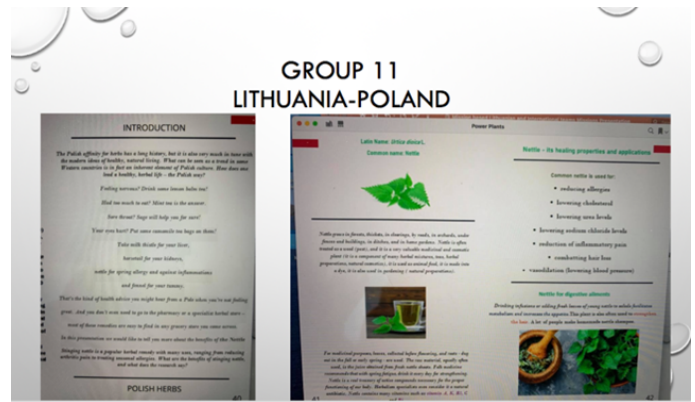


Due to the pandemic restrictions, the student mobility originally planned to have been held in Poland was organized as an online event in April 2021.
